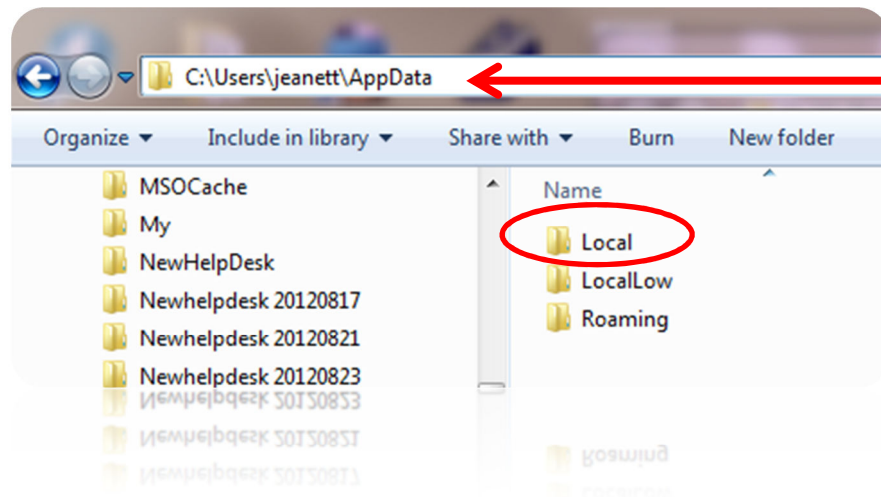





Correct Excel Timetable Not Displaying in Excel

1. If your Excel timetable is not showing, please do the following:
 - 1.1. Go to **Windows Explorer**.
 - 1.2. Click on **(C:)**
 - 1.3. Open **Users** folder.
 - 1.4. Open your **user folder**(It will be the user you login with on your computer).
 - 1.5. Open **AppData** folder.
 - 1.5.1.If **AppData** does not exist, please do the following.
 - 1.5.1.1. On the address it shows which location you are in e.g.
C:\Users\jeanett
 - 1.5.1.2. We need to force the **AppData** folder to appear in your user folder, therefore we need to type **\AppData** at the end of the address.
 - 1.5.1.3. It should be **C:\Users\jeanett\AppData**


REMEMBER THAT jeanett IS AN EXAMPLE OF A USER FOLDER, THEREFORE IT WILL BE A DIFFERENT NAME ON YOUR COMPUTER.



- 1.6. Open **Local** folder.
- 1.7. Open **VirtualStore** folder.
- 1.8. Open **ProgramFiles** folder.
- 1.9. Open **EdusolSAMS** folder.
- 1.10. **Cut** the latest Excel timetable you have created.

- 1.12. Open **ProgramFiles** folder.
- 1.13. Open **EdusolSAMS** folder.
- 1.14. **Paste** the Excel timetable you have cut in this folder.
